### Transport

**Getting to Rostock** **By plane:** Airport Rostock-Laage, or airports in Berlin and Hamburg.  
**By train:** from Berlin central station 2:45 h and from Hamburg airport about 2:30-3:00 hours. More at [www.bahn.de](http://www.bahn.de)  
**By ferry:** There are ferry connections from Rostock to Gedser, Trelleborg, Turku and Helsinki. More at [www.ferrylines.com/en/ferries/baltic-sea](http://www.ferrylines.com/en/ferries/baltic-sea)

**Getting to the venue** It takes appr. 20 min to reach the venue from the Rostock central station on foot or 5-10 min by tram or taxi.  
**By tram:** From the Rostock central station you can take the following trams (single ticket: 2 €, no credit cards):

- No. 5 direction “Mecklenburger Allee”
- No. 6 direction “Neuer Friedhof”

You should get off at “Kröpeliner Tor”.
