- Project platform pitch on 7 November** You will have the possibility to pitch your platform idea with project partners from Interreg Baltic Sea Region and other programmes. For this, please complete the project platform idea form, attached to the seminar invitation and available at the Programme website. Send it back to platform@interreg-baltic.eu by **31 October**.
- Individual project platform consultation on 8 November** If you wish an individual project platform consultation to discuss specific issues concerning your platform idea, please indicate this in your online registration form. If you have any specific limitations (e.g. flight leaving early), please state them in the section “Remarks” in the online registration form.
Afterwards, please complete the project platform idea form, attached to the seminar invitation and available at the Programme website. Send it back to platform@interreg-baltic.eu by **31 October**.
Only after receiving your project platform idea we will confirm your slot and send you information about your consultation in a separate email. Participants will be assigned to the consultation times on the “first come, first served” basis, once the complete idea forms are received.
Consultations will take place on 8 November between 9:00 and 13:00 in the same venue. Each consultation will be max. 45 minutes.
A helpdesk is planned to be open too, for shorter questions devoted to contents or finances.
- Travel & Accommodation** All participants are expected to make their own arrangements for travel and accommodation.

Transport

Getting to Potsdam **By plane via Berlin Tegel:** With the cab it takes approx. 30 minutes and will cost about 55 €. With public transit you can get to the hotel by taking bus no. 109 or X9 to the station “Berlin Zoologischer Garten”. From there take the train no. 7 to “Potsdam Hauptbahnhof” (central station).

By train via Berlin central station: With the regional train RE1 towards “Brandenburg/Havel” or with the train no. 7 to “Potsdam Hauptbahnhof” (central station). The train ride will take 30-45 minutes.

Getting to the venue From the Potsdam central station it takes approx. 10 minutes to reach the venue by foot over the “Lange Brücke” (long bridge).

Catering Lunch buffet, coffee/tea and refreshments.

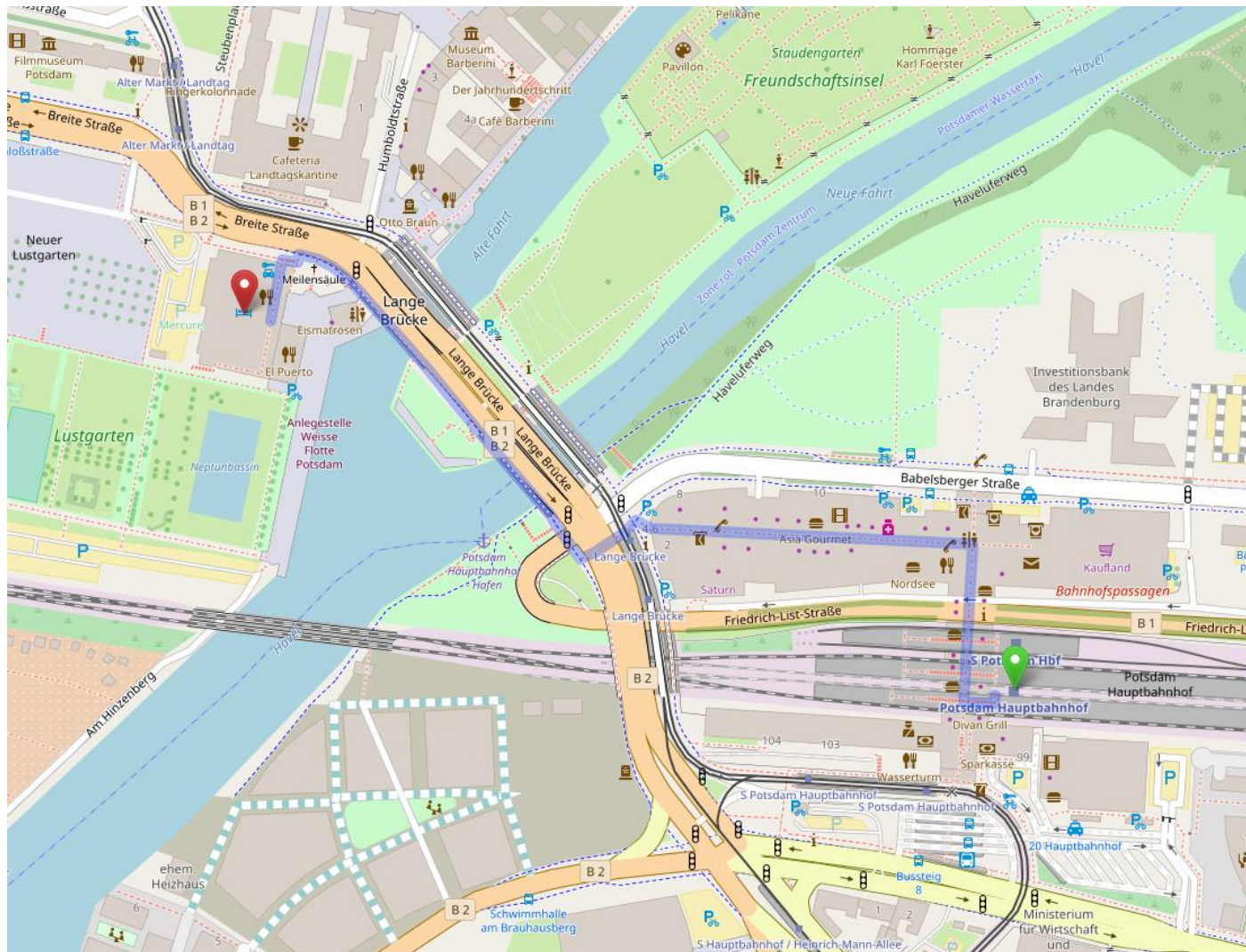
Language The language of the event is English.
